

Local Rules:

Embedded Ball: The embedded ball rule applies "in all grass area through the green" except in a hazard. This excludes all desert areas.

Tree Wells: Tree wells are considered "Ground Under Repair" with relief available if either your swing or stance is affected by the tree well.

Rip-Rap Drainage Rocks: Rip-rap rock is considered "Ground Under Repair" with relief available when either your swing or stance is affected

Immovable Obstructions Local Rule F-5: The Player may take relief under rule 16.1b if an immovable obstruction is on the line of play and is: within two club-lengths of the putting green and within two club-lengths of the ball.

Aeriation Holes: "[Through the green](#), a ball that comes to rest in or on an aeration hole may be lifted without penalty, cleaned and dropped as near as possible to the spot where it lay but not nearer the [hole](#). The ball when dropped must first strike a part of the [course through the green](#). On the [putting green](#), a ball that comes to rest in or on an aeration hole may be placed at the nearest spot not nearer the [hole](#) that avoids the situation.

Out of Bounds

Is defined by the course/hole-side edges at ground level of boundary walls, perimeter fence posts, street curbing, roads, white stakes and white lines connecting markers.

Catalina Course

Hole #10 defined by left margin of lake on #18 and continues to end of stakes. In course Out-of-Bounds on hole #10 does not apply to hole #18.

Hole #18 defined by the right margin of lake on #1 and continues to end of stakes. In course Out-of-Bounds on hole #18 does not apply to hole #1.

Dropping Zones

Sonoran Course

Hole #6 All Tees: Left side of green past water

Hole #10 Dropping Zones are an additional option of a ball unplayable in the wash on hole #10- Right side of green beyond the wash

Hole #15 Blue, White, Red, & Gold Tees drop on forward tee box

Catalina Course

Hole #4 All Tees: Fairway short of the green

Hole #18 All Tees: Front of Red tee box
